

Aftercare

It is very important for producing a beautiful and lasting result.

First 2 hours... Blot your eyebrows with clean tissue as often as you can to get rid of the excess fluid until it's dry. On the day of the procedure, clean the brows with damp cotton pad followed by the ointment after 2 hours, Then repeat every hour before bed time. Day 2- Clean your brows 3-4X a day using damp cotton pad followed by ointment. Repeat for 3 days. On the 5th day onwards, do not touch your eyebrows as scabbing will start to form.

Do not wet the area or splash with water and no sweating for 7 days, do not sleep on your side for 7 days, do not scratch, do not pick. Use clean Q-tip to touch brow area.

Apply the ointment when it gets itchy - use a Q-tip. If the ointment is too stiff to use, simply warm it up in a glass of warm water or on your finger. Use the balm very sparingly. Too little is better than too much. Blot off excess ointment with a clean tissue. Never touch the procedure area without washing your hands, use Q-tip.

Do not scrub, do not rub or do not pick at the epithelial crust that forms. Allow it to flake off by itself. If it is removed before it is ready the pigment underneath it can be pulled out. Purchase new mascara and makeup if possible to avoid contamination or bacterial infection.

Do not use any makeup near the brow area including mascara for eyeliner procedures for at least 7 days.

Always use a sun block after the procedure area is healed to protect from sun fading.

What's normal? Mild swelling, itching, light scabbing, light bruising, and dry tightness.

For **Eyeliner** and **Lip procedures**; Ice packs are a nice relief for swelling and bruising.

Too dark and slightly uneven appearance. After 3-7 days the darkness will fade and once swelling dissipates unevenness usually disappears. IF they are too dark or still a bit uneven after 4 weeks then we will make adjustments during the touch up appointment.

Color change or color loss. As the procedure area heals, the color will lighten and sometimes seem to disappear. This can all be addressed during the touch up appointment and is why the touch up is necessary. The procedure area has to be completely healed before we can address any concerns. This takes about four (4) weeks.

Needing a touch up months or years later. We recommend the touch up 8 weeks after the first session (included in today's price) and every 8-12 months to keep them looking fresh and beautiful. Permanent makeup can be faded more quickly with sun exposure or certain types of prescription medications. Touch up sessions after 6 weeks to 12 months will be \$250 (+tax) or current touch up rate at time of touch up.
